# Harpsichord variations

AUSTRIAN MUSIC for harpsichord and clavichord, played by Igor Kipnis. CBS Odyssey.

THE harpsichord side of this out-of-the-ordinary release introduces two little-known composers in Poglietti and Fux in addition to presenting Beethoven's 'Six Variations' on a duet from the opera 'La Molinara' by Paisiello played on the instrument for which they were conceived.

This was an early work composed in 1795 shortly after his arrival in Vienna from Bonn; it is entertaining but musically of slight interest compared with the fine 'Chaconne in D' by Johann Fux who is now only remembered as the writer of the 18th century 'bible' of music theory 'Gradus ad Parnassum'. This is a relatively long and quite serious work of considerable power and beauty.

On the other hand, the 'Canzona and Capriccio' by Alessandro Poglietti, who was Imperial Court Organist in Vienna from 1661 until he was killed during the Turkish invasion of that city in 1683, is an example of early program-music. Subtitled 'On the Cackles of the Hen and the Crowing of the Rooster' it is an amusing and whimsical piece in the Italian style of the time.

The clavichord side opens with the 'Suite No 26 in B minor' by the German composer Johann

IT has to be the Dorsey brothers of course, along with Eddie Lang, Hongy Carmichael and, like the advertisements say in another context, 'many more'.

Brian Rust wrote the notes so they are lucid, informative and historically accurate.

The tracks come from bands and times when the Dorsey brothers were emerging from the pack as it were and preparing for big futures. They were well-known and respected but greater fame was to come.

In the 17 chosen tracks, recorded between late

March, 1928 and early October, 1929, the listener is given the opportunity to hear the brothers solo and in concert with some of the great or very good musicians of that time, and in some of the great tunes of then, and now.

The listening is easy.

**JELLY ROLL NORTON, The Library Of Congress Recordings, Volume One, Swaggy, mono, SI311.**

WHATEVER the im-

pression that Morton conveys in the opening sides of an invaluable series, and that impression varies with every spin of the turntable, the collection must rank uniquely historically and musically. Morton talks, pontificates, probably exaggerates wildly and almost certainly, from a base in known fact, fabricates during this series, but then to be human is not to be humble as all honest men know.

What he does do, besides illustrating musically that he was still a consummate piano player although ill, is enfold the listener in his voice and his tales and take him on a pilgrim's way through early jazz. It may not always be fact, apart from his music, but it sure as hell is fascinating.
